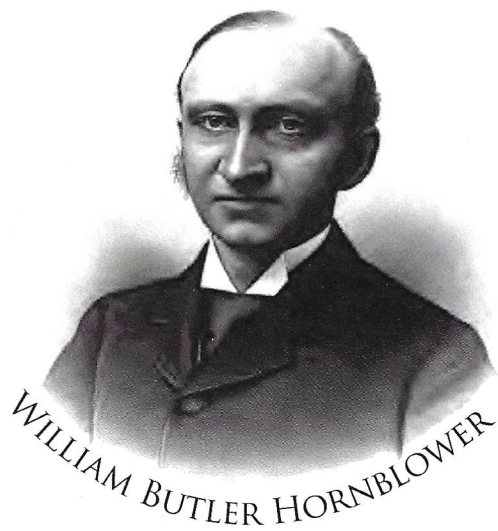


WILLIAM BUTLER HORNBLOWER MAUSOLEUM

WOODLAWN CEMETERY, BRONX, NEW YORK



(MAY 13, 1851 – JUNE 16, 1914)

BORN IN PATERSON, NEW JERSEY, HORNBLOWER WAS A **PROMINENT NEW YORK CITY LAWYER** AND, LATER IN LIFE, A **JUDGE OF THE NEW YORK COURT OF APPEALS**.

HE ATTENDED PRINCETON AND **COLUMBIA LAW SCHOOL**. HE STARTED TWO SUCCESSFUL LAW FIRMS, HORNBLOWER & BYRNE AND HORNBLOWER, MILLER & POTTER. HIS CLIENTS INCLUDED **THOMAS EDISON** AND **ULYSSES S. GRANT**.

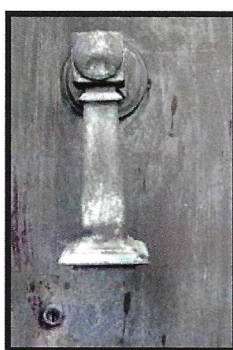
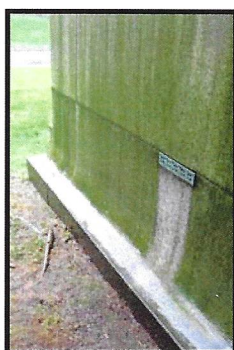
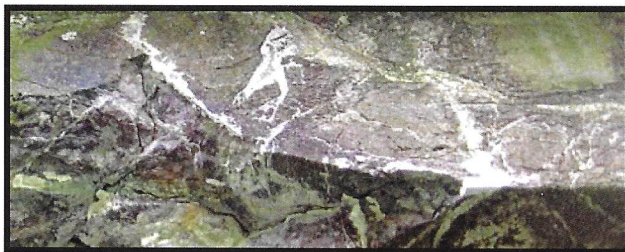
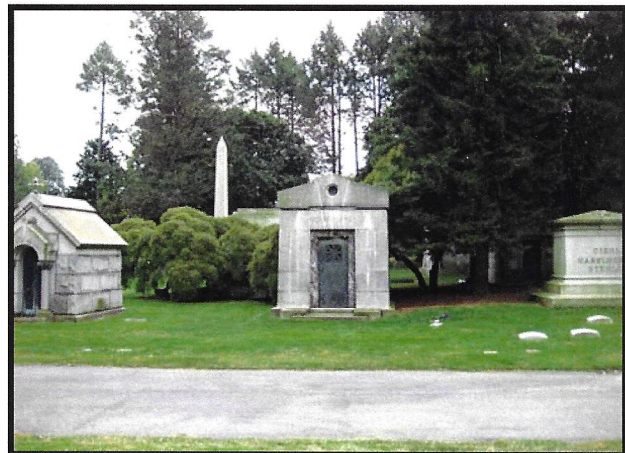
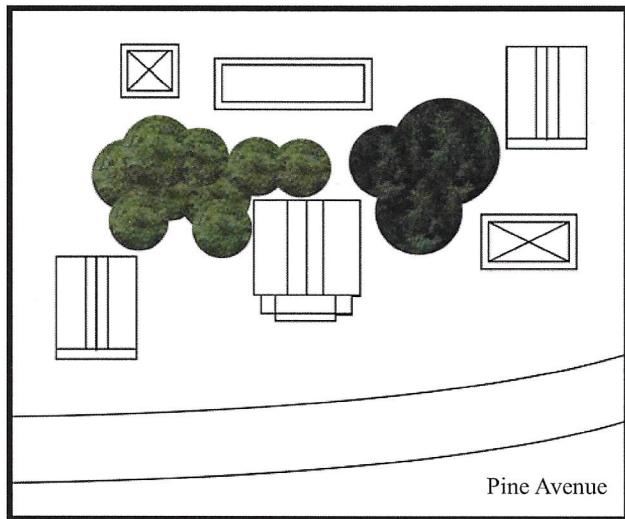
A **CLOSE ALLY OF PRESIDENT GROVER CLEVELAND**, HORNBLOWER WAS NOMINATED TWICE FOR A **SEAT ON THE SUPREME COURT**.

THE **NEW YORK TIMES** CALLED HIM A "**LAWYER OF REMARKABLE ABILITY**," AND THAT HIS "VOICE WAS OFTEN RAISED IN PROTEST AGAINST THE FORMS OF POLITICAL QUACKERY WHICH BECAME SO COMMON IN...HIS TIME."

HORNBLOWER WAS THE ELECTED PRESIDENT OF THE ASSOCIATION OF THE BAR OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK AND THE NEW YORK STATE BAR ASSOCIATION.

HE DIED OF HEART PROBLEMS AT 63, LEAVING HIS WIFE EMILY SANFORD AND ONE DAUGHTER, KATHERINE.

Interior marble is similar.

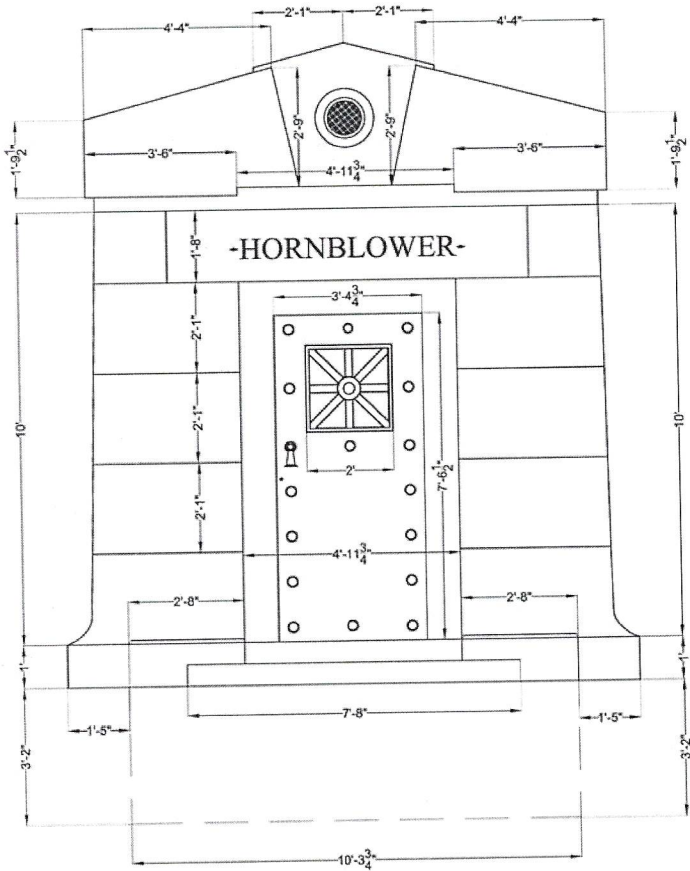

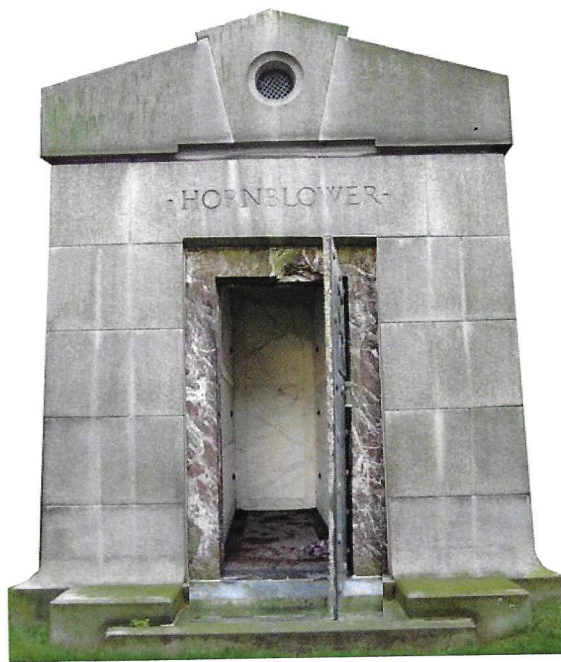

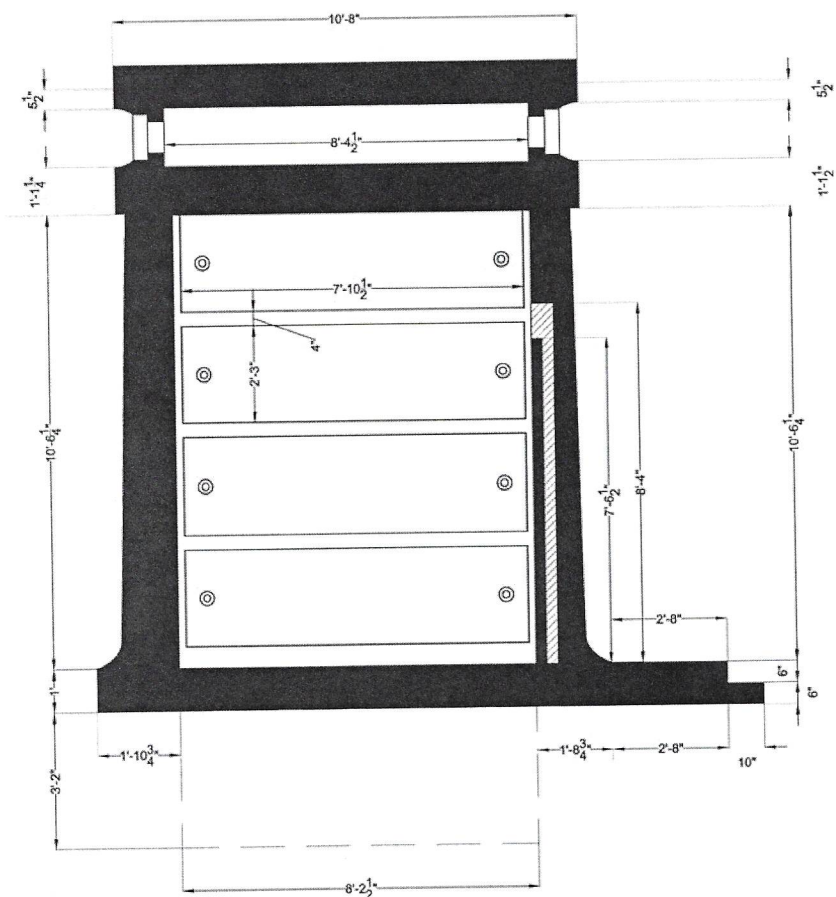
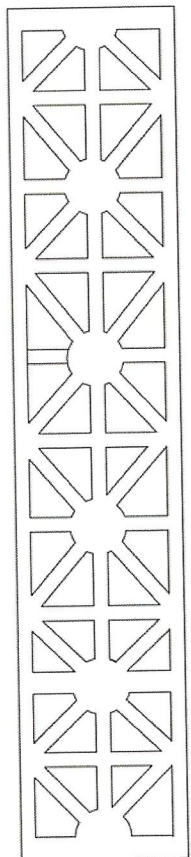


ELEVATION
