I. COURSE DESCRIPTION

The *Capital & Partnership Structuring with Advanced Excel Modeling* course offers understanding of how various financial products in the capital markets are structured, and how various partnerships are structured in the real estate private equity market. In addition, the understanding of such structures is bolstered through building excel models in class to analyze the structures.

The course is structured as introducing the concepts first and then walking through how the concepts are utilized in the market via documentations and excel modeling analyses.

Students will be expected to have a strong command of Microsoft Excel, and good understanding of the basics of capital structures and partnership structures.
