
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Concept Section Diagram



Type III : 0% Co-living (only Circulation) Our residential project explores various co-living

modes. First, We divide the unit clusters based on the degree of privacy. The privacy gradient varies from 0%, 60%, and 100% from the bottom to the top. Whereas the top level is for individuals that prefer the most private space, each unit is a quiet realm for one family with minimal chance of encountering. The bottom level is an entire co-living community, and users share


major infrastructures, including bathrooms and kitchens. We intend to explore this co-living system as an alternative lifestyle for people living in high-density urban areas like New York.



After determining the concept and completed the site survey, we decided to use curved structures to vertically run through the entire building, and our core programs are also hidden in these curved structures. The first reason is that the curve can better guide people's flow of action in such a shared space and reduce the sense of boundary. The second reason is that most of the buildings around the site are straight-line spaces like storage warehouses. We want to use curves to activate the entire area, making the site more lively, and attract more people to come here to live.






The Kingsbridge Armory is a decommissioned armory in the Bronx. It was built in the 1910s, and Its military use ended in1996 and remained vacant until now. What if the Kingsbridge Armory itself became a city? Our proposal creates a city within the Armory that can provide inspiration, enlightenment and education for community residents and subtly affect their lifestyle.

The road system follows the Armory's or ginal grid. Internal city blocks are designed to create space. Over time the city can be redivided into new plots of large or small size to meet the needs of different investors. At the same time, we pursue the use of lighter, sustainable and easily buildable materials to create our city.






2. Empty Blocks/Plazas:




3. Void Blocks/Courtyards: We punched void blocks

for the courtyard which are deep into the -2 basement. People can easily go up and down through the geometric shaped stairs in these courtyards and see what is happening below to create another layer of experience.




Axonometric Physical Model






The food gained will be used for the hotel kitchen, which makes the whole process as a closed loop supply chain.




The food wasted by the residents can be locally collected at the basement and resued as nutrients to grow the vegetables.




Floating farms in the hotel as an intervention to utilize the waste resources planting vegetables and create a self-sufficient system.







Ground Floor Plan








It is a linear architecture that keeps changing its structure and programming from the land to the ocean. In order to rethink the relationship between the land and ocean, and also the relationship between structure and programming.

As we know, the ocean is dynamic, dangerous and immense, by contrast land is a stable, safe place for people. And dune is like a transitional space between them, buffer the waves shocks and resist the erosion.

So designing an lifeguarding can show that characteristics on the dune guides my design logic. Starting from the concrete structure, it changes from thick square columns to thin walls, and the gap changes from a wide distance to a narrow distance.


















The name of our school is schools within school. The contrast between Solid vs Void guides the overall design of the building. The building is divided into a rhythm of solid and void spaces, which provides the framework for further dividing up spaces that are occupied by enclosed programs versus by open lobbies and atriums. From ground floor to upper floors, programs go from large collective to more small scale enclosed.

Ground Floor Plan


The building envelope system takes separate strategies for the sides where the building opens up towards the larger cityscape, versus the sides that are more hidden towards the inside of the block. For the south and west facades, we designed a curtain wall system with perforated aluminum panels as an additional layer for the classrooms behind. Those systems also worked with our sustainability strategies in which a curtain wall with operable windows allows the movement of light and ventilation, the double facade provides shading. The sustainability approaches are further grouped by adjacency while thinking about ventilation and energy change on the city.




